SUBJECT: Accreditation Statement for the Army Electronic Product Support (AEPS)
Web Site

1. References:

c. The AEPS Accreditation Documentation, including the System Security
Authorization Agreement (SSAA) and accompanying appendices.

2. Reference "a" granted the AEPS Web Site an Interim Approval to Operate for six
months until the following conditions were met:

a. Incorporate more detailed guidance on securing AEPS servers into the AEPS
SSAA. Following the guidance already established by the Department of Defense
Information Technology Security Certification and Accreditation Process (DITSCAP) to
develop a Security Configuration Management Plan.

b. Ensure all AEPS servers are protected by the intrusion detection systems currently
being fielded under the AMC Guardian program.

3. After further review of the completed documentation and the successful installation
of Guardian at Rock Island Arsenal, as the Designated Approving Authority for the
AEPS Web Site, **Full Accreditation** to store and process information at the sensitive but
unclassified (SBU) level is granted.

4. This accreditation is valid for three years from the date of this memorandum, unless
the Certification Authority determines that a re-certification is required based on a major
component change. The Information Assurance Security Officer (IASO) will maintain
the record copy of the SSAA, the Certification memorandum and DAA Accreditation
memorandum.
